NORTH BRANCH COMPLETES CONSTRUCTION NEW SUTTON DPW BUILDING

(Sutton, NH) North Branch Construction, Inc. of Concord, NH has completed construction of a new DPW building for the town of Sutton, NH. North Branch was the design/build contractor for this new 9,984 square foot \$1.2 million facility, which replaced an existing 44-year old 2,900 square foot highway garage. Construction began in late May with the demolition of the existing facility.

The new wood framed building features 7 bays (including a wash bay), office space, a break room, a locker room, a cistern and sprinkler system. Construction was completed in mid October two and a half weeks ahead of the contract schedule. TF Moran, Inc. teamed with North Branch providing civil, structural and architectural engineering.

North Branch Construction, Inc., one of the largest construction firms in the State of New Hampshire, has been serving their clients construction needs since 1958. Recent projects include Dalianis House (conversion of former furniture store into Veteran's Housing) in Nashua, NH and the new Windy Hill School at Colby Sawyer College in New London, NH.
